

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-17

OAKLAND TOWNSHIP, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE ELECTING TO ESTABLISH A NON-UNIFORM PENSION PLAN TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM PURSUANT TO ARTICLE IV OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT LAW; AGREEING TO BE BOUND BY ALL PROVISIONS OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT LAW AS AMENDED AND AS APPLICABLE TO MEMBER MUNICIPALITIES.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED that the Township of Oakland Code of Ordinances Chapter 1, Administration and Government, is hereby revised by adding Article 10, Non-Uniform Pension Plan, as follows:

**CHAPTER 1
ADMINISTRATION AND GOVERNMENT**

**ARTICLE 10
NON-UNIFORM PENSION PLAN**

SECTION 1-1001. Oakland Township (“Township”) hereby elects to establish a Non-Uniform Pension Plan for its full-time, union employees to be administered by the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System (“System”) in accordance with Article IV of the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law, 53 P.S. §881.101 et seq. (“Retirement Law”). The Township hereby agrees to be bound by all the requirements and provisions of the Retirement Law and the Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard and Recovery Act, 53 P.S. §895.101 et seq., and to assume all obligations, financial and otherwise, placed upon member municipalities.

SECTION 1-1002. As part of this Ordinance, the Township agrees that the System shall administer and provide the benefits set forth in the Oakland Township Non-Uniform Cash Balance Pension Plan entered into between the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Board and the Township effective as of the date specified in the Adoption Agreement.

SECTION 1-1003. The passage and adoption of this Ordinance by the Township is an official acceptance of the provisions of the Base Plan Document and the associated Adoption Agreement (collectively referred to as the “Plan”) and the financial obligations resulting from the administration of the Plan.

SECTION 1-1004. Payment for any obligation established by the adoption of this Ordinance and the Plan shall be made by the Township in accordance with the Retirement Law and the Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard and Recovery Act. The Township hereby assumes all liability for any unfundedness created due to the benefit structure set forth in the Plan.

SECTION 1-1005. The Township intends this Ordinance to be the complete authorization of the Plan and the Plan shall become effective on the Plan effective date specified in the Adoption Agreement.

SECTION 1-1006. A duly certified copy of this Ordinance and the executed Plan shall be filed with the System as soon as administratively feasible after their execution.


