ORDINANCE NO. 2002 – 2

AN ORDINANCE **AMENDING** BUILDING THE **PERMIT** ORDINANCE BY REQUIRING A 60 FOOT SETBACK FROM THE ROAD RIGHT OF WAY, A 15 FOOT SETBECK FROM **YARD** SIDE THE REAR OR **PROPERTY** LINES AND **ESTABLISHING** THE PROCEDURE AND **STANDARDS FOR** MODIFICATION OBTAINING Α OR VARIANCE THE SETBACK REQUIREMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE SUPERVISORS OF OAKLAND TOWNSHIP this <u>8th</u> day of <u>August</u>, 2003, as follows:

Chapter 3, Article I, Section 3.104.A. of the Oakland Township Consolidated Ordinances pertaining to Building Permits and Occupancy Permits is hereby amended by adding Section 3.104.A.5, as follows:

- 5. (a) No building permit shall be issued unless the building, development or mobile home is set back more than sixty feet (60') from the right of way of the existing local or proposed streets, sixty feet (60') on arterial streets, applicable in the case of corner lots to both intersecting streets.
- (b) No building permit shall be issued unless the building is set back more than fifteen feet (15') from the side or rear lines of the property on which it is erected.
- (c) Variance/Modification. The Board of Supervisors may grant a variance/modification to the setback requirements set forth in (a) and (b), above, so long as all five of the following requirements are met:
 - (1) The request is set forth in a writing;
 - (2) There are peculiar, unique or unusual circumstances as to the land (not the building on the land);
 - (3) The modification is not contrary to the public interest;
 - (4) The grant of a modification encourages orderly development; and
 - (5) The grant of the variance/modification is the minimum modification possible.
